

I found in this book a clear path to recovery. As a person who has experienced first hand the effects of verbal abuse, I can say that Ms. Evans' book brings with it validation and the tools necessary for one to recover and rebuild the self after experiencing this type of psychological trauma. This book provides a space for healing to those who have had their minds warped by verbal abuse. She makes it very evident that verbal abuse is not just saying mean things to someone. There is brainwashing, destroying one's self-concept, the use of power and control to suppress attempts of assertiveness on the victim's part, plus many more examples of covert and overt abuse. Victory over Verbal Abuse is filled with a variety of healing therapies and guidelines. You will learn how to heal, not just cope with the aftereffects of abuse. With weekly affirmations that instill a positive foundation in your day to day, followed by specific exercises to aid you step by step over a period of time, you are sure to reclaim the life you were meant to have.

I haven't gotten through the whole book as yet, but I will say that reading the first handful of pages struck a chord with my reality to the point where I sat and cried. I know and purely understand no one is perfect, and that doesn't leave any room for excuses. However, knowing how to face a really tough issue with someone whose life story has quite a few bumps in it as well really does help and this far, I believe Ms. Evans' book is a true gem.
