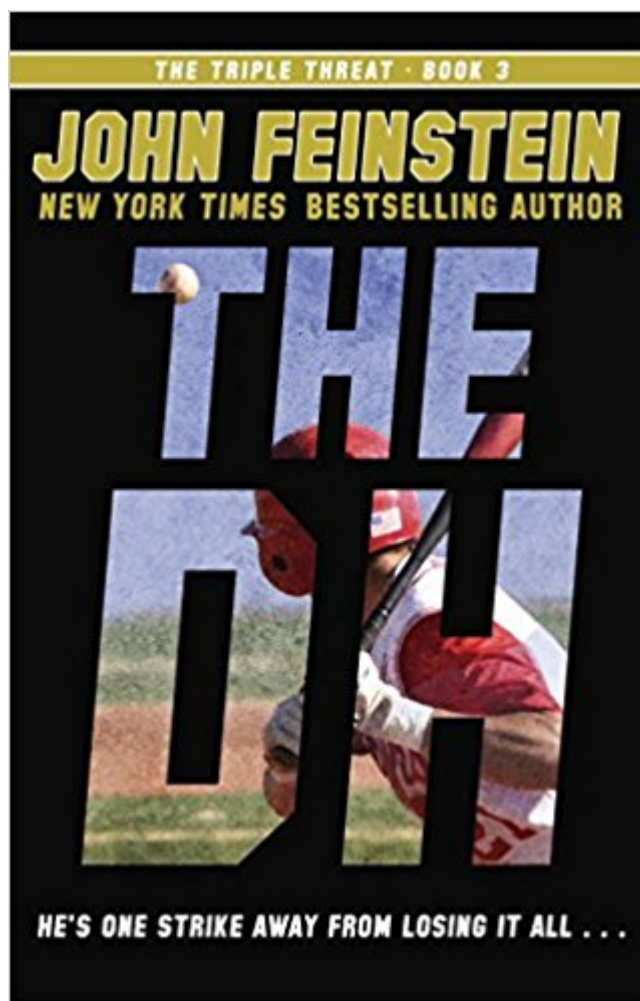

Once again Feinstein allows us into the backstory of the characters, understanding some of what they are dealing with outside of the game and how the family that is the team sometimes has to rally around the other to make sure they are ok.
