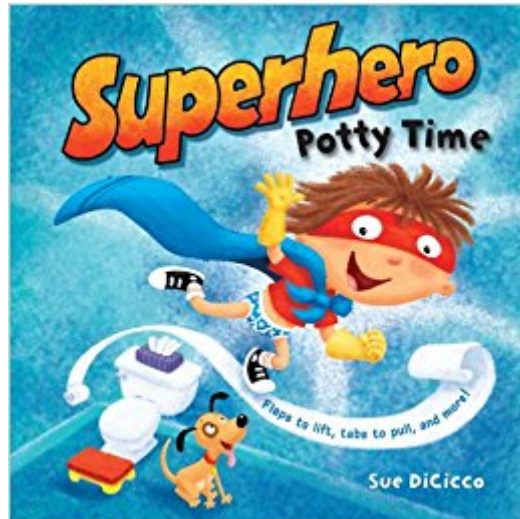

Cute book! My daughter had the girl version. My son likes it but it can be pulled apart easily. Flimsy pull out parts in the book.

The content of this book is great; my two-year old son loves to "flush" the pee away and says, "bye bye pee pee!" every time. It definitely has him interested in the potty and does a great job explaining how the process works. It also gives an extra boost by encouraging boys to be "superheroes" and go in the potty. But, the pull tabs are flimsy. I reinforced them with packing tape to keep them from tearing. By the second day, my son easily removed the toilet paper tab and I had to tape it back

together and re-insert it. Now, we keep this book up high where he can't reach it and only let him read it when my husband and I can supervise. We also have "Potty" by Leslie Patricelli. My husband and I, as well as our son, all like that one a little better.

This was my little guy's favorite potty training book. I wish the pull tabs were stronger. My son isn't overly rough, but with typical 2 yr old wear they tore after about a month.

Nice book for potty training

This book is not for kids to flip through and use, as I was reading it to my son I realized that even I had a hard time moving the stiff parts and I wound up accidentally breaking one of the pieces trying to slide it as it was supposed to go. I imagine that even if the parts were not so stiff that I would not trust my son not to rip the whole thing apart anyway. He is not a particularly destructive boy, he's just an average 3 year old.

This book has gotten my son excited about potty training in a positive, low key way. All of the flaps and moving parts in the book allow him to participate in the potty process storyline. And the plot is simple enough that by the second read, he was telling me the story. So in many ways it has allowed him to take positive ownership of the process. He loves im the book and so do I.

This is a really cute book that my 3 year old son just loves. I also bought the Superhero costume from Melissa and Doug and gave them both to him as a Christmas present. The illustrations look a lot like the costume! Be aware, though, this is a book you'll want to keep up when you aren't reading to your child as it is not durable. We've already lost one piece of the toilet. :)
