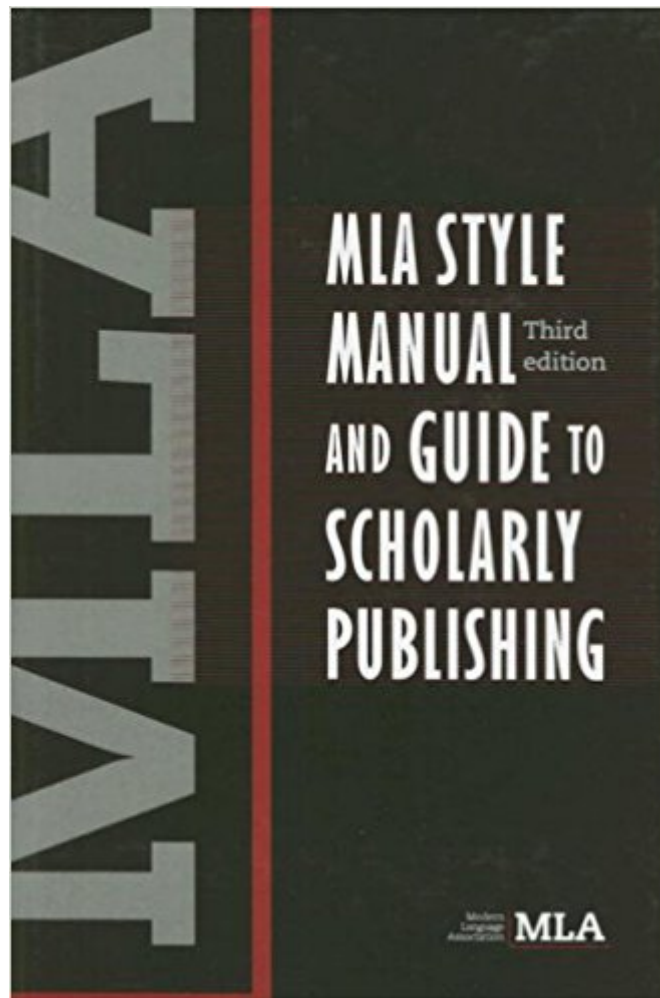




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MLA Style Manual And Guide To Scholarly Publishing, 3rd Edition
