

Loved this book. Have read much on the pilgrimage, but this added a special insight...not only from the priests religious insights that struck him at various points, but also his sense of humor. He gave the realities of a hike of this magnitude (500 miles!) and some of the experiences that made this hike especially poignant. I loved this book so much I bought one for a deacon who is being ordained a priest in June.

I loved Father Dave's down-to-earth, humble yet holy approach to walking the Camino. It is my dream to make this journey myself someday, but in the meantime he has made it more real to me. His spiritual observations and epiphanies are shared with humor and humility.
