

The maps in the original book are hand drawn and often don't include street names, just basic directions like make the first right after the wash and drive 2.5 miles lol That's my kind of adventure! Now that I've got some gaps filled in I'll be sure to keep this book in the car for the next time the exploration bug hits! I can't wait!! docked it 1 star just cuz the maps are so crude in the original, but computers weren't too common then so ya can't be too hard on the guy ;-)

For anyone who is tired of the same old "tourist traps", this book is for you. There are a wide variety of treasures to be found in Arizona and Rick Harris has drawn maps for many of them.
