

No identifiable cause. 95% of hypertensive patients, often develops gradually over years.

Goals of Treating Hypertension, JNC 8³		
Population	Goal BP, mmHg, Initial Drug Treatment Options	
General <60 y	<130/80	Thiazide-like diuretic or ACEi
General <60 y	<140/90	or ARB, or CCB, alone or in combination ⁴
Diabetics	<130/80	Black, thiazide-like diuretic or CCB, alone or in combination
CKD	<130/80	ACEi or ARB ⁵
Goals of Treating Hypertension, GBD⁶		
Black, lower risk	<135/85	Thiazide or CCB
Target organ damage or CKD risk	<130/80	-
