

## **Synopsis**

The treatment and care of those with cystic fibrosis has developed rapidly over the last decade, with a resulting increase in the number of individuals living well into adolescence and early adulthood. This book deals with the profound psychological impact of these changes on sufferers, their friends and families, and those involved in patient care. Where relevant, chapters include an update of current knowledge, discussions of the clinical implications of current and future research, and guidelines for clinical practice.
