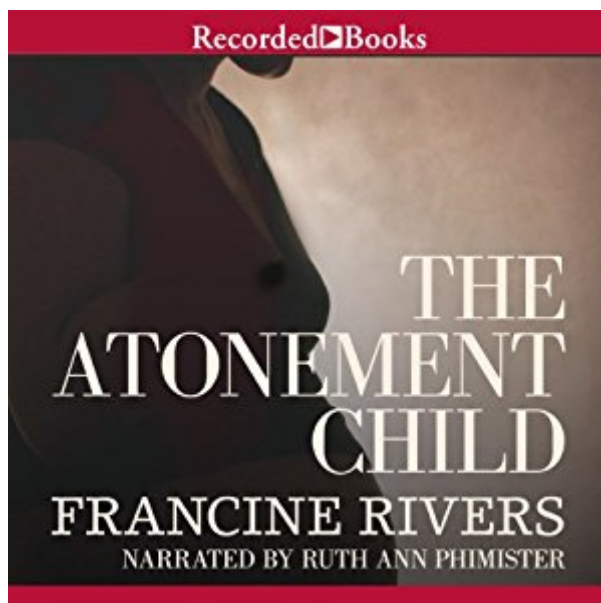

As in the trilogy series *Her Mother's Hope*, there was the theme of one character having suffered with tuberculosis and having to neglect her child for health reasons. Overall, however, I did enjoy reading the book and will definitely read anything written by Francine Rivers in the future.

The story gripped my attention; it was hard to put the book down. This is a powerful book that raises hard, real questions. It forces the reader to enter into the story and live Dyna's life with her. Interspersed with the reassuring voice (word) of God, it elicits a desire to pray hard as the reader feels the pain and struggles with the main character. In the end, God's strong voice and His perfect ways win the day! This book addresses a tough subject, but ends victoriously only because the main character is willing to trust God in and through the pain. God makes a way!
