

This is a tough review to write, because the book is actually very good. The problem is the title. The title implies that hydroponics is an important focus of the book, but it isn't. The book has about 20 chapters, and only one, the 13th is about hydroponics. In addition the chapter contains only vague details about how to setup and use hydroponics. The book would be much better titled: "Gardening Indoors", then it could get the ranking it deserves.

I am just starting into Hydroponics for the first time. I will grow some hot pepper plants indoors. I had read a lot of different info on the web and did learn a little. But almost all the info I could find was about growing pot! Growing vegetables is just not the same, yes captain obvious here. I wish I had found this book first however, as it would have saved me a lot of hunting and wasted time. It is a very complete and organized source of information on this subject. It explained lighting very well and without it I would not have been able to do this. He explains how to figure out how much light you need and how to provide it. I wanted to use fluorescent lighting and could not find any detailed info on the subject. This book covers the entire subject of indoor gardening and not just lighting. He covers growing in dirt or hydroponics. I would highly recommend this book to anyone starting a garden indoors for the first time. Or if you have tried to grow vegetables inside and just did not do very well.

This book fails to impress. I have spent a few hours a day for 2 weeks reading all I can find online about indoor gardening and hydroponics but I cannot say I would have saved time buying this book and reading it instead. In 2 hours of reading this book I was more than 1/3 thru it and I had learned nothing that I had not already learned for free. In addition, the material in the book is presented in a haphazard fashion and much of the material is repeated twice or more times. I would say this book is about 10-20% useful information that you could have found for free with a few internet searches, and about 80-90% fluff. There are some sections where the pics and captions will tell you all you need to know but then the author needlessly rewrites the same info in confusing blocks of text after it. Then there are other blocks of text that severely need informative pictures and captions to visually illustrate key points, however the pictures and captions in these instances either don't exist or are of poor quality. Other sections contain purely confusing or contradicting advice. For example, the author recommends putting seedlings under HID light to provide a drying element, but then later says seedlings should be grown under fluorescent lights until flowering. There is no uniform voice or tone to the book, it just feels like a regurgitation of info that the author hurriedly skimmed before cutting and pasting it in the book. So in summary this book will waste your time and money, give you

no clear path to how to start an indoor garden hydroponically or otherwise, and leave you confused by its terrible explanation of important topics like PAR, and pruning, all the while providing no logical progression of the series of events that must take place in order to nurture a seed to a full term vegetable harvest.

After seven years of purchasing books here, this is my first review. I think so highly of this book I had to write a review. High quality product, and information. This book may not have enough meat for a graduate student to use but certainly the greenhouse owner or gardenstore worker will benefit greatly. Nice depth in wide array of topics. Good full color photographs used liberally throughout the book. Very best information available on lighting in the greenhouse or indoor applications. I have read a full dozen books on hydroponics, and greenhouse operations for the home grower or small farm. This is the best. If you need one book this is it.

This is a great book loaded with information. Great for the beginner, answers lots of questions. The only problem is that the Kindle version is missing pages. There are blank pages or when you go to the next page you know you missed a lot of information. I would recommend buying the book and not the Kindle version.

Disappointed to discover that this book contains almost identical information (some of the same paragraphs and photos) as 'Marijuana Horticulture, The Indoor/Outdoor Medical grower's Guide' by Jorge Cervantes (an alias of George Van Patton). 'Gardening Indoors With Soil & Hydroponics' is a neutralized and disguised version (no mention of cannabis). Neither book delves into LED lights.See MIRTH's (of Texas) 2 star review for more thorough information.

This book really helped to to kick start my indoor gardening project. Information about indoor lightning is really great. Strongly recommend.
