

Girls and guys ARE very different in what they think they want in a relationship and what they really need to feel fulfilled. This is written in a way I think is very easy to read and understand why guys and girls act the way they do when relating to each other.

I would recommend this book to all young women looking to know why guys act the way they do and what they are actually thinking. The authors share stories from their own lives, and talk about topics such as purity, modesty, character, appearance, and much more, all from what they've heard from guys they've interviewed who were between the age of 15-20. For each topic, they show the survey results, and quote what different guys said about the topic. It was really eye-opening to hear advice from real guys, hear from them their struggles, and their encouragement for girls.

This is a great read for young women who want to have a more solid foundation before pursuing serious relationships with men.

I am using this as Sunday School lessons with my teenage girls Sunday School class. They, like me, are enjoying this and it is very helpful to understand why guys do the things they do. We are even going to take some of the survey questions and poll our teenage guys class to see if we get

similar results.
