I bought this book for the express purpose of a companion book. The Angel Tarot deck has never been an easy deck for me to use, I personally did not care for the art work, so I was looking forward to this book to give it another try. I am not a professional Tarot reader, but not a beginner either. I actually really like this book. As another reviewer mentioned, the book is basic, but for me that's the reason I like it. This book gives you the the card name and a brief general meaning, the place of the dreamer on his journey (major arcana), the symbolism for the card, the angel, the angel number, and people (for the court cards), and the astrology. The book gives you the general meaning of the minor arcana suits and numbers, general language of the Tarot, a snapshot of the Dreamer's Journey, and much more. The quality of the book itself is really quite nice. I have not used the cards I purchased when they first came out much, now with this book I am picking them up more and playing with them, and I have been happy so far. If you are looking for deeper meaning to the major arcana, I really like *Â Tarot and the Journey of the Hero* by Hajo Banzhaf. But for the Angel Tarot, I'm liking this book just fine, it's simple and easy to use, and serves my purposes. UPDATE: 7-5-2014 The more I use this book with the cards, the more I am falling in love with it. It is very well thought out. I had mentioned above that it is basic, but there is a wealth of information and insight within these pages. I appreciated how they followed through with the Archangels on the different Major Arcana cards. For example: Archangel Haniel is on both the High Priestess card and again on The Moon card as there are common attributes shared by both cards and it links the two nicely. The more I use the book, the more I am seeing the magic in the pages. It has opened so many doors with these cards, I love it! Thank you Doreen and Radleigh for this beautiful book.

Used with the Doreen Virtue Angel Tarot Cards this is a good book for the basics and fundamentals of learning how to do angel tarot readings. It has a lot of good information and tips on how read and use your own intuition to do a reading for yourself and others.

I am taking the Certified Angel Card Reader course online, and so I bought this book as an additional reference. I am enjoying the course very much; Doreen Virtue and Radleigh Valentine are excellent teachers. I was less thrilled with the actual Angel Tarot Cards, mainly because I find the images so "busy" that I almost feel I need a magnifying glass to see all that's there, and sometimes

the image does not, to me, illustrate the card's meaning clearly. I also hoped for more actual angels on the cards, but angels are used only for the Major Arcana. That said, this book is a big help because it describes the symbolism on the cards, which in many cases is very different (intentionally, according to the authors, who are concerned that some people find some of the traditional images scary or negative) from what you will see on traditional Tarot cards. The booklet that comes with the cards themselves gives a general meaning for each card, but this Big Book of Angel Tarot delves more into the symbols, which gives a lot more depth. The one thing I wish is that the cards were pictured in color, rather than black and white. It really helps to see the card as it really looks while studying the text. I do have the deck, but I don't want to have to search for each card as I read through the book. For that reason, I gave the book 4 stars instead of 5. The book is only \$9.27; I would have happily paid more to have color images. I hope Doreen and Radleigh will produce a color version. The book is otherwise well produced, with substantial, glossy paper and a very readable type-face. At first glance, the book seems kind of simplistic. However, the more I read it, the more I appreciate it, and I can see that the authors very intentionally and lovingly crafted the descriptions of each card, and I've concluded that they left the descriptions somewhat "open" to leave room for the card reader's personal intuition to play a role in interpretation. The writing is conversational, upbeat, friendly, and engaging. Astrological information is included, which is not especially of interest to me as I don't know astrology. There is also a section for each card on the card's Angel Number. The Angel number and its meaning is given, but without any explanation as to WHY that number means what it does. We are referred to Doreen's book, *Angels 101*, for more information. In a "Big Book" of Angel Tarot, I think more on this should have been given, especially as numbers feature largely in tarot interpretation. All in all, I think the authors poured a lot of love into this book. It is definitely only for THIS deck, and will take some adjusting for those used to a more traditional Tarot deck. But it's a great resource for Angel Card readers.

I waited a long time to get this book and I am finally glad I did! This is the perfect reference tool to use along with your Angel Cards by Doreen Virtue. I decided to get in on my Kindle/iPad for easy portability and reference while doing readings. If you are a card reader, you cannot go wrong with this manual.

Not really necessary as the booklet inside the deck gives great descriptions, but nice to have, especially if you are new to Tarot.
