If you are into, what I call, perfectionist interior design (all rooms look like they belong in a hotel) then I would say this book is not for you. I found this book to be very disappointing. After following all the work he posts on his website I thought it would be different. The pictures on his website are so vibrant and interesting and the ones chosen for this book were so bland and boring. I understand that they can't put everything in the book, but at least choose more interesting people. I think Selby made the book too hipster and as a result it took away from the artistic element.

This is an interesting book, but for me it is not really worthwhile to look through again and again. I prefer overall views of homes, and it focuses on the little details more than I find useful. I think it's better to see how the rug itself ties the room together, rather than a close up of the rug with feet on it.
