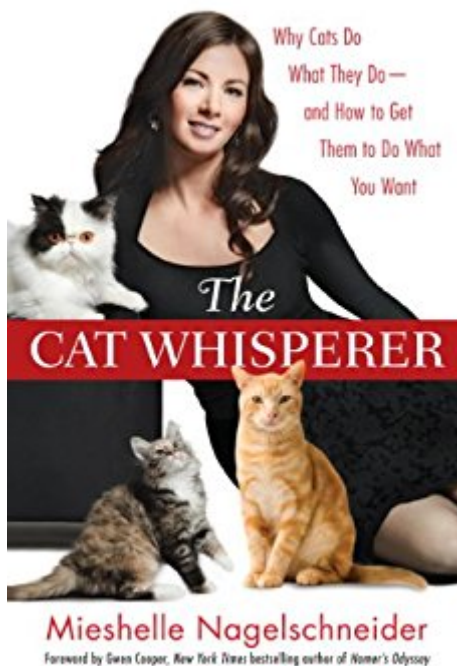

My "found" cat (dumped at a local park) started out so sweet, the perfect cat. After a few months she started up with middening. I was desperate. It's been nearly a week since I got this book and started following her tips, not a single inappropriate elimination in that time. This book has been a godsend for my household. I've had cats as pets my entire life and thought I knew all about them. Boy, was I wrong!

Excellent book - well written in a very readable style. Her suggestions were more user-friendly and

easier to implement than those in some other books on cat behavior. As an aside - I have never declawed my cats - and abhor the practice - but I was especially touched by the sample case history in the book. I cannot believe that anyone who reads that would continue to support this barbaric mutilation of innocent animals. She is also not dogmatic about pushing any particular diet. Her book focuses more on cat behavior - and how we, as guardians, contribute to this behavior unwittingly. Fixing a cat issue therefore means fixing our own role in the issue.

I thought it was good advise. I had two cats that are 5 yrs. old and brought a new cat into the house. She is only 1 year old. They are all girls and have all been spayed. I don't know if she wants to play or fight. She is quite the aggressor. I bought some FELIWAY and used it. It has some pheromone in it which she recommends that you use. It has helped some but not as much as I would like. I have a large family room that has 16 foot ceilings and I think that may have something to do with it. I also have a sitting room that has regular ceilings in it and I have put another one in that room. I also do the sock thing where you rub it on the cats that have been in the house then you rub it on the new cat. I think that has worked. I have done other things that she has recommended. LaVerne

It does address Feral cats but mine is not. Human socialization is not addressed sufficiently especially when it comes to breeder cats. It does cover new kittens.
