

This is not a complete guide. If it were a paper book, it would look like a comic book. Each of the 83 'must-visit' points of interest has a page in the "book" with a picture, a one-sentence description, and a link to online info. And the great reviews of the book? The "book" was published February 25th and 9 of the reviews (all good) were posted between February 28th and March 4th. Does that look suspicious to anyone else? Eateries recommended include a diner, a food co-op, a donut/pastry

shop, a burritos joint, a college bar, a Mexican joint, an ice cream joint, a vegan joint, a "hipster" coffee joint, a pizza and beer joint, a "cool" joint for lunch near the university, a student hangout joint, another coffee joint, a taco joint, another pizza and beer joint, a beer joint, a fish taco joint, a sandwich joint, Trader Joe's, and Whole Foods. Anyone over 25 would probably want more diverse options. Places to hangout while you're in Tucson include the university (to throw frisbees), a bike shop, a "hipster hangout" lounge, REI, the bike shop - again, a rock climbing gym, the university - again, and a crossfit gym. This is a visitor's guide for college students and (apparently) hipsters. There are probably people looking for that. But marketing it as a "city guide" is misleading. It's not for most visitors over 30, especially not visitors with children. Save your \$2.99.

This is an excellent tour guide to the wonders of Arizona. Anyone planning a visit here needs a really good guide as there is so much to see and do. The process of eliminating rather than gathering places is most important, you cannot see and do it all on any single trip. In addition distances between are a big issue, takes careful planning and routing to get the most out of it. There are still routes that go on for two or three hundred miles without seeing anything but desert. This book does the trick, I must say. With lots of beautiful photos and various links to attraction websites, this is a must have book for any travel freak:-)
