

I purchased this item based on one 5 star review, as that's exactly what I was looking for. I was looking for something non-fancy but would hold the normal letter size sheets, as most of the awards, artworks and schoolwork happens to be on the standard US letter size 8.5"X11" paper. This record book DOES NOT hold the papers of that size without folding. Please see the pictures I have uploaded. I took a picture of standard sheet on the record book and inside one of the envelope as well so you can compare the size of the book against the standard paper. You can also see the papers being crushed (if you keep them straight without folding)if you pull the elastic tie over. I won't

mind folding school work etc. but I don't think anyone would like folding certificates and artwork. Like many people, I buy products based on reviews by people. I take the product rating very seriously and don't write reviews unless I do a thorough study to be fair. If you are looking at storing folded papers and smaller size docs/photos, this one shall do, otherwise please look at other products. Thanks for reading. Hope this helps. I am sadly returning this product.

This scrap/record book is great! It's just what I wanted. It has places for school, class and other photos, somewhere to write little tidbits and favorites, a place to put papers and artwork, and it runs the gamut of pre-K to the end of high school (U.S. standards). As some had noted, it is not 11 inches tall, so it doesn't accommodate full 8 1/2 x 11 paper, but all the books I looked at were this way, and we get much larger projects home anyway. I always scan art projects before folding them if I am worried about preserving original quality. It is sturdy, and the pages open easily without worrying about breaking the binding. One feature that drew me to this book over similar products is the fact that it wasn't designed with a young kid focus. Since this is to be used through high school, I didn't want something with a children's design. In addition to the versatile visual design, the questions and options change over time to fit the age of the student, and there is a nice page at the end for a senior to write about their dreams for the future. I am very happy with our purchase. I am considering purchasing one for my two-year-old right now to ensure I get this design.

I used to have a little one of these when I was a kid, so I am thrilled to have found these for my boys. The book is smaller than a 8X11 sheet of paper. So if you don't want to fold papers to fit in it, don't get it. The book is great, without being cute, so it works for both boys and girls. There is room for making drawings, tracing hands, writing about one self, and putting a signature and a picture for each year in school. I am hoping the book lasts for 12+ years (as it is spiral bound).

It is big enough to secure art projects, report cards and daily work sheets for the ages. Considering that the book will be used for the next twelve years, it also looks sturdy enough to last. I let my kindergartener put his own papers within the folds. It also has a prekindergarten slot for preschoolers. Love it. I am also purchasing another for my 5th grader so that I can redo the smaller book that she has. It is a great buy for the price.

I got this book for my sister's triplets (one book for each) and my sister and I were very pleased! I love that this book includes Pre-K as many similar books did not, and it goes all the way up to 12th

grade. It's great to be able to keep all school years in one book. I also loved that there is a photo spot for each grade level and that there are writing prompts for each section about new friends, how the child felt on the first day of school, and spots to write their favorite songs, colors, etc. It's a fantastic way to summarize the year and offer a snapshot into the school year and the child's likes at the time that they can look back on in later years. I really like that it doesn't take much time to complete each section for the parent, but it still makes a great memory album. I'm giving it 4 stars because I do wish there was more space to write or add your own things to each grade other than the prompted items. Also, while I love the pockets to hold artwork, awards, and report cards, they do NOT hold standard size paper (8.5x11), meaning you have to fold them. Overall, a highly recommended record book for parents!

I love how much info this book captures about each school year. It is so nicely laid out with pockets for memorabilia. It loses one star for that big round green sticker on the cover. It's an ugly sales message having nothing to do with the book and it does not peel off. I had to use baby oil to get it off which lifted the paper on the cover a bit and it left a mark on the book.

I had a book similar to this when I was in school and wanted to get one for my daughter now that she is in school. I chose this one because of the larger size and pre-k section. As other reviews have mentioned it will not fit 8 1/2 x 11 paper unfolded but I'm okay with folding paper to fit in here. The pages inside are not glossy so writing in pen won't smear. The information to fill in will capture memories and will be great to read over in the future. How to remove the green sticker on the front ---- use a hair dryer to warm the sticker for a minute, then start to peel back the sticker slowly with the hair dryer still on the sticker. You can aim the heat on the top or from underneath to release the glue. The sticker will come off almost effortlessly and if there is some sticky residue you can use the sticker to remove what remains. The book looks great without the sticker.

You have to fold things to be able to store them in the pouches, but if you're okay with that then this is great. One thing to be warned about though is that if you glue things in this book even with just a glue stick, the glue can end up warping the other pages in the book! So when you glue something in there I would recommend setting the book up so the page can dry before you close it. This might be common knowledge for people who scrapbook a lot but I didn't know this and ended up warping some of the pages in my book.
