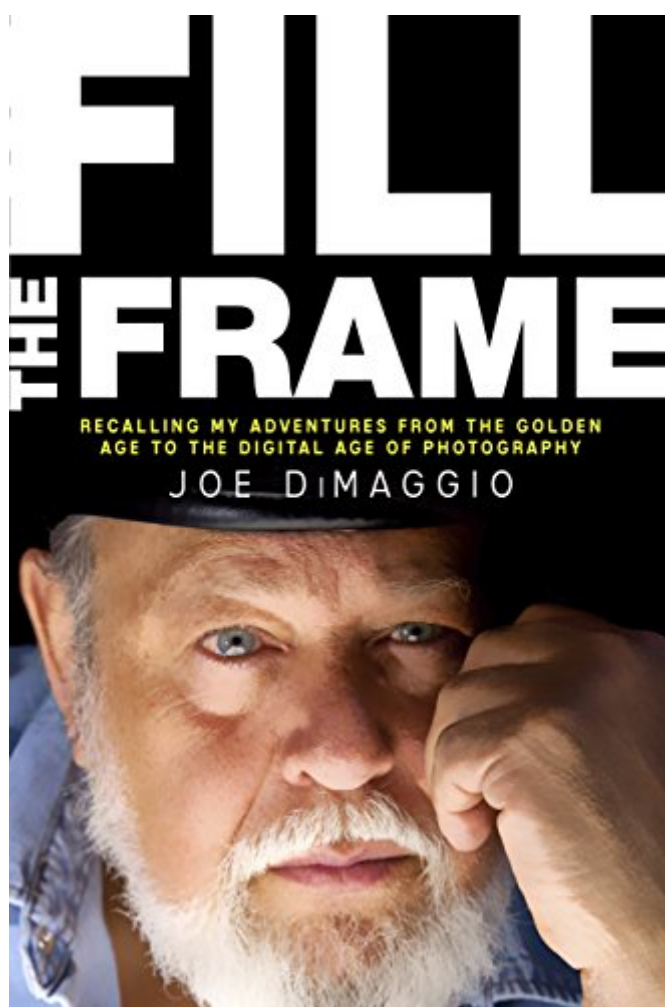

During that time Joe has crossed professional paths with an amazing number of famous subjects from a number of walks of life, including sports, music, and politics. It's a shame when someone with great personal stories doesn't share them with others, and it's great that Joe has put these events to paper for us to read. Joe takes over 80 photographic experiences and recounts in a few pages each how an idea was transformed into works of art. It's fascinating to read about the chance encounters in some of the events, the times that Joe had to exhibit thinking on his feet (one of the greatest strengths that a photographer needs) when an assignment didn't go as first planned, and the way that Joe often connected to his subjects in a way that positively helped the final product. It also adds to the enjoyment the fact that Joe never takes himself too seriously. To say that this book is a "quick read" is an understatement, because you just want to keep reading!

I purchased this directly from the author's site and have just finished reading it. I found the book an easy and interesting read. The small chapters are typically focused on Joe's interaction with and image(s) captured of a specific person. The stories are always fun to read even if I don't know the subject or have not cared about them in the past. I especially enjoyed his story of shooting Henry Kissenger! Although not a "photo book", the images are reproduced nicely and I am always tempted to look at them at the end of the chapter before reading the chapter. :-)
