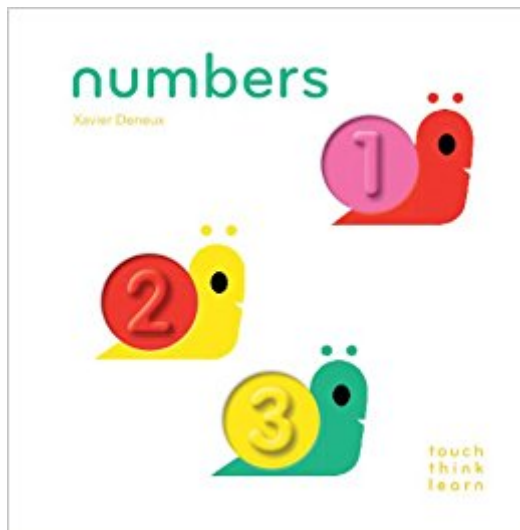

Xavier Deneux studied at Beaux-Arts de Paris. He has worked as a graphic artist, creating posters and decorations for various industries, and has illustrated more than forty children's books. He lives and works in Paris, France.

This series of books is unlike any children's board book I have ever seen. The images are simple and the raised and indented portions of the page are really helpful. My 1 1/2 year old has already learned most of his numbers 1-10 from this book. We count the images on the left side of the page

and then trace the number on the right side. It is crazy that at just a year and a half my son is pointing out zeros whenever he sees them on a sign, other book, etc. I highly recommend these amazing books by Xavier Deneux that will help your children experience reading through touch as well.

This book is okay. It's a cute book, but you really need to use it with your child. On their own, this book is confusing for a child about what objects they are supposed to be counting.

It's elegant, but the colors and pictures are a bit boring. Kind of artsy, with really thick pages.
