

3.5 stars. Again, the book was too short for all the issues packed into it. I like the team dynamic in the series and I liked Becker but Kendall was kind of wishy washy with how she interacted and thought about her ex-husband and I think Becker was a lot more understanding of her continued contact with him than any other boyfriend would have been. I didn't get a good feel for the timeline

in this one. It did seem like they fell in love really quickly, especially with Kendall's doubts but that wasn't that big of an issue.

I received a copy in exchange for my honest review. In Scoring at Love you meet Beck who is a goalie for the San Antonio Generals and Kendall who is the mother of one of the children at the hockey camp that Beck is at for the summer. Kendall has concerns about her son Tristan learning to play the goalie position and has agreed to meet with Beck to discuss this. Lucky for Beck Kendall is also single and they both find each other attractive. Lucky for Kendall, Beck is a patient man and is not scared off by her daughter's disability. Scoring at Love was a sweet, fun read. It had some real life situations in it and was nice to see how an athlete handled dating a woman whose daughter had a disability. I'll be looking for the other books in this series (although you can read this book as a stand alone).

This was my first time reading anything by Michele Shriver and I must say that I thoroughly enjoyed this sweet story. Michele Shriver has given us a story with well developed characters and the plot was so realistic and very well constructed, and their issues that they faced were real world issues that every day people deal with every day. This story focuses on Becker Lawson who's the goalie for the San Antonio Generals, and he's also one of the coaches for the young Generals hockey camp. Then there's Tristan Meyer's who wants to attend the goalie portion, and he really wants to be a goalie. But his mom Kendall thinks it's just too dangerous of a position for him to play. But when Becker talks to Kendall about letting Tristan try it, will he also convince her the recently divorced mother of two to give love a second chance. It also provided depth by adding different situations to the plot like being a single mother after a divorce, having a child with special needs, and how these type of situations strain new relationships and make people refrain from them. Becker, goaltender for the Generals, decides to spend the summer training kids in the team's summer camp. He knows talent when he sees it, so when Tristan tells him about his dream of being a goalie and his mother's reluctance towards it, he decides to try and persuade her without knowing that he'll want to be more than her son's mentor.
