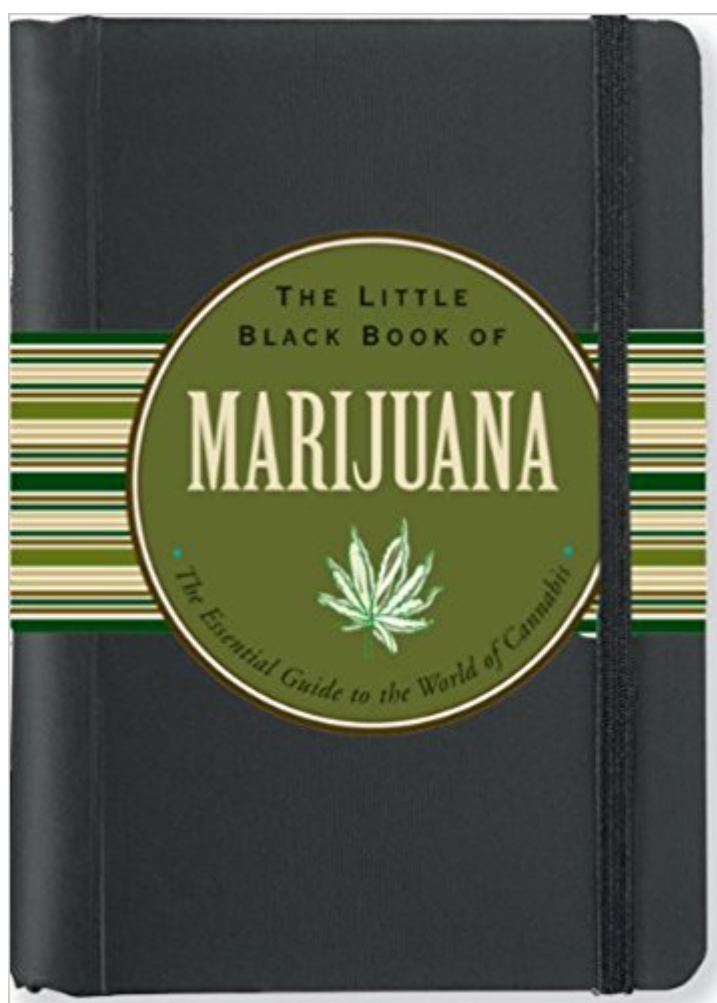

This little black book is quite resourceful. It has many links and websites to go to and lookup. Such
