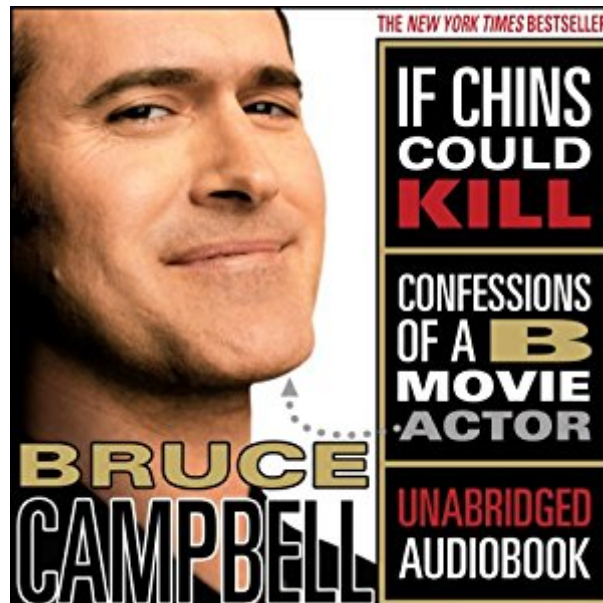




The book was found

"If Chins Could Kill" is a great first book for Bruce Campbell. His early life and his career up to the point of publication are chronicled in a humorous, yet insightful fashion. You feel like you really get to know Bruce during the course of the book. I found his stories and trials and tribulations very interesting. He really is the Hollywood equivalent of a blue collar worker, and goes to great lengths to praise the hard work done behind the scenes by crew and production members. It rings true, not an attempt at being patronizing. I get the impression that Bruce loves what he does, is happy with the level of fame and notoriety that he has achieved, and just wants to work. He appreciates the work of the average joe, and that shows up again and again in the book. Some reviewers have cited how helpful this book would be for people attempting a career in acting or the arts. While that's true, you don't need to have any interest in acting, or even in Bruce Campbell's movies in order to enjoy the book. There was a lot I could relate to, and I'm in a completely unrelated career than him. I think the book works on two levels: If you're a fan of Bruce's movies and work, then you will of course enjoy the anecdotes and behind-the-scenes stories of his movies and other projects, including the Evil Dead films, but not limited to that. Even if you aren't a fan of his movies or are just unfamiliar with them, then there is much to relate to, as far as trying to succeed and persevere in the career field of your choice, where sometimes things go well, and sometimes they don't. Bruce Campbell has stuck with acting through the thick and thin of it, and that's something that we can all draw inspiration from.
