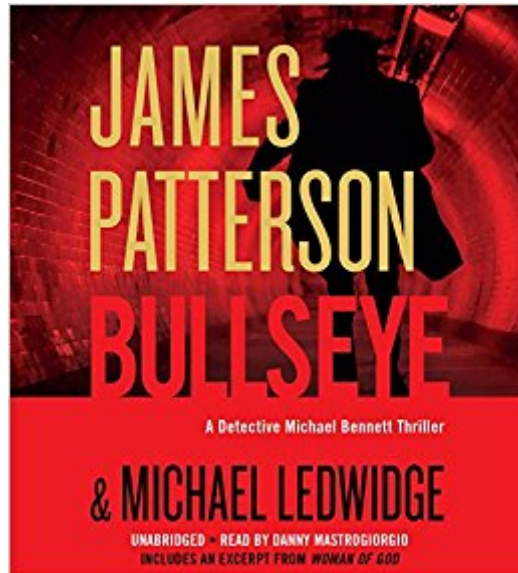

I also was disappointed that the "family" which is usually more involved in the story line wasn't. While I would hate for this series to end, I hope that James Patterson looks back on what made the series great to begin with and if there will be another book, more family and more Mike and Mary Catherine.

Every thing just tied up into a pretty package and it all happened so fast and I couldn't believe it was over. Also I think Michael and Mary Catherine have to make some sort of commitment. What I didn't like about the book was there wasn't much about the family life just a small segment with Brian which really wasn't that realistic. Again it was OK but not the standard of the Michael Bennett books.

I found this to be a good mystery. Good action throughout with the main plot and a subplot. The theme borders the contemporary with Russia as a possible villain. This was a hard book to put down. Excitement right up to the end.

Having read all of the Mike Bennett books this one I found somewhat disappointing. I've enjoyed

that his story is not only about him and his work but also about his family life and this book didn't really have much about his family at all.

In this latest Mike Bennett/James Patterson novel, there is a British assassin, purported to be the World's Best assassin who has a contract to kill the President. Is it the Russian mob, the British assassin, or the husband & wife killers? There are more turns in this than that fancy, twisting turn in San Francisco. Well paced, great characters, but my one complaint is that he didn't tie up all the loose ends.....
