

In 1997, underground comic artist and zine publisher Robin Bougie began Cinema Sewer magazine, an ode to the seamier side of film and the culture which surrounds it. Bougie used his geek knowledge, his artistic skills as comic book artist, and connections in the world of porn to give birth to this unseemly but loveable publication. Printed comic-sized on cruddy newsprint, the magazine found an audience amongst film fans looking for something totally different. Bougie contributes liner notes for dvd releases and has now self-published almost 80 comic books since he was 18.

Ahh, the first. To be the first reviewer of Cinema Sewer is the depraved cherry atop my degenerate sundae of moral awfulness... or should that be awesomeness? Volume 3 did not disappoint! It's just as chock full of vintage porn, exploitation film reviews, and amusing sleaze-hound anecdotes set in comic book form. I loved Volumes 1 and 2. Was glad to see the format and quality hadn't changed. And #3 actually (finally!) mentions H.P. Lovecraft which, I believe, was my only real gripe about the earlier Cinema Sewer books. I don't always share the author's particular taste, but I definitely get off on reading about his love for weird, sick, and outrageous films. The only Achilles heel I can think of is that Robin occasionally used the word "palatable" when he actually meant "palpable". A small thing, easily corrected in Volume #4 - which I eagerly await.
