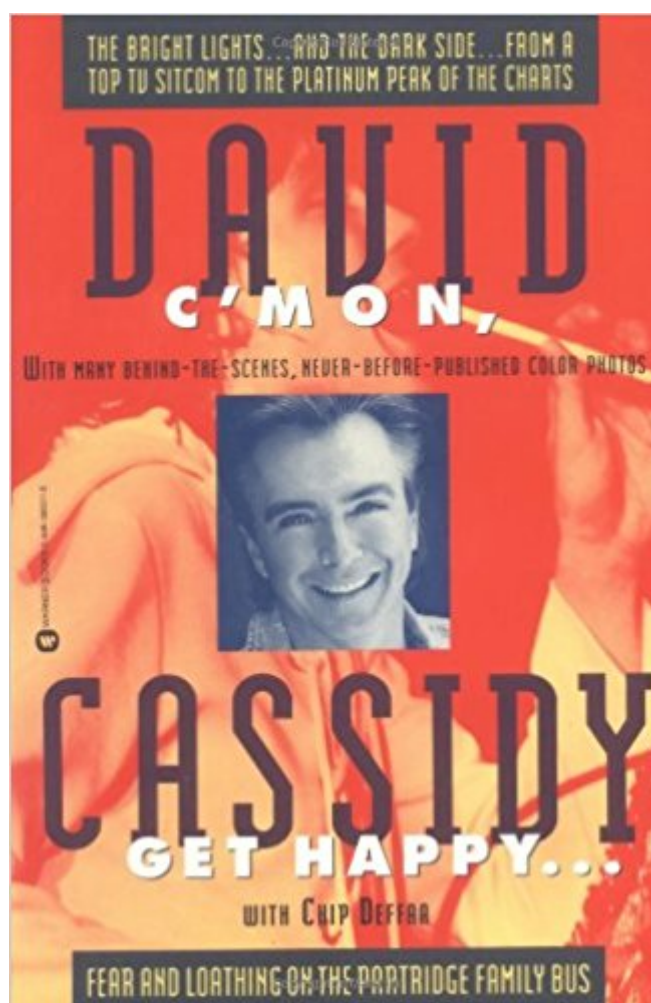

This was an interesting book for me because he stated clearly how much money he made, spent, and lost. He was remarkably foolish with his teen idol earnings, but he was a kid and hardly the first to blow a fortune. I do not think his behavior with women was unusual; I have heard worse from only mildly well-known regional bands. He was funny on The Partridge Family and I saw him onstage in Joseph and the Technicolor Dream Coat; I thought he performed well in that venue. I hope he feels like he has redeemed himself and can think about retiring and spending time with his children.

Pretty good book, not too surprising. In it, David tells about another author who collected a lot of info about him and his life and going to write a book but for some reason it didn't work out.. After reading this book I noticed there was another one about his life "Could it be Forever" and read the first chapter on a review, and it was almost the exact same book as the "C'mon Get Happy" one I had just read. Apparently this was the book that the info had been collected to write, and the 2 books are basically the same. Just the "Forever" one seemed to have comments in it by other celebrities (John Lennon was on) about David and his career. So, if I had to pick one of them to buy I'd probably by

the "Fovever" one and get the same story with a little more.

Cassidy does not hold back in telling his story. Blunt, frank, and sometimes searingly honest, David tells all. Especially interesting was how he and his agent were tricked out of millions of dollars due to a misleading contract. I like the fact that Cassidy and his co-author wrote the book in his own voice. When you read it, it's like David is telling you his story, rather than having a sanitized version written in perfect prose by a ghost writer. It's a definite must-read for all Cassidy fans. My only criticism is that David wrote about his Partridge Family years in great detail, but glossed over his post-Partridge years. Hopefully he'll consider doing a fuller autobiography.
