

Last year I took a group of 10 hikers to walk from the North Rim to the South Rim in one day. This entailed two mammoth tasks; logistics for the trip and getting 10 middle aged men into the shape to complete this arduous task. Although this book will not actually tell you how to do either of those things, it does give a great introduction about how you need to start thinking about it. I also bought Hikernut's Grand Canyon Companion which was actually the perfect book for me, it carries a great deal more information you will need about logistics and planning a trip. It is mainly a (very good!) description of the trails but as I said it was also a great place to start as I planned the trip. The trip was a complete success btw, due to an enormous commitment by the participants to get in the right shape.
